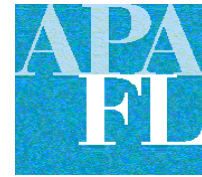

*(Located on the East Side of Congress Avenue)*

**From INTERSTATE 95:** Exit at Yamato Road (Exit #48). Go west on Yamato Road to Congress Avenue. Turn right and go north on Congress Avenue approximately 0.8 miles to 6500 Congress Avenue.

**From NORTHBOUND TURNPIKE:** Exit at Glades Road East (Exit #75). Go east on Glades Road to Jog Road. Turn left and go north on Jog Road to Yamato Road. Turn right and go east on Yamato Road to Congress Avenue. Turn left and go north on Congress Avenue approximately 0.8 miles to 6500 Congress Avenue.

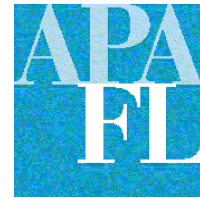
**From SOUTHBOUND TURNPIKE:** Exit at Atlantic Avenue East (Exit #81). Go east on Atlantic Avenue to Congress Avenue. Turn right and go south on Congress Avenue (approximately ¼ mile past Clint Moore Road) to 6500 Congress Avenue.

You can park in any non-designated spaces around the building.
